Bob Feldman, Actor. Feldman began working with Richard Maxwell in 1996 in *Champions of Magic*, followed by *Flight Courier Service*, *Ute Mnos V Crazy Liquors*, *Joe*, *Henry IV Part 1*, *Showcase*, *Good Samaritans*, *People Without History*, *Ads*, and *Neutral Hero*. As a jazz saxophonist he has performed with Max Roach, Charles Mingus, Sonny Simmons and many others. He has performed with rock bands, jazz groups and his own trios and quartets all over the United States and Europe.

Jim Fletcher, Actor. Fletcher is a founding member of New York City Players. He has also worked with the Wooster Group, Elevator Repair Service, and the British theater company Forced Entertainment. Fletcher has worked with Maxwell for fifteen years. He is something of an instrument and has worked with a diverse array of artists, from the choreographer Sarah Michelson to the art collective Bernadette Corporation (he helped write a novel and a poem), and with the publishing house Semiotext(e).

Richard Maxwell, Writer/Director. Maxwell is the Artistic Director of New York City Players. He has produced work with the Whitney Museum of American Art, The Kitchen, Reena Spaulings, and the Walker Art Center, among other places. He is the recipient of a Guggenheim Fellowship, two Obie Awards, and the Doris Duke Artist Award.
